- Email the library photos of both sides of the reading log or drop your log off at the library

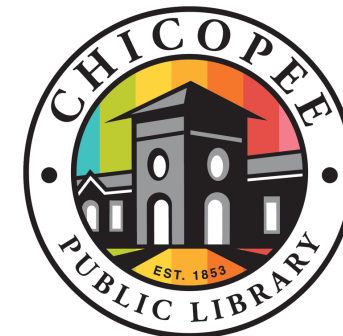
